Last Saturday, ten members of the StMS National History Day Team, along with coaches Mrs. Cline and Mr. Gauthier, joined almost 500 other students from across the state in the NC NHD Contest held at the NC Museum of History in Raleigh. These entries represented the top performers of the 5,000 NC students that participate in NHD. It was a great day for StMS as all three entries were recognized for their achievement. Participants and their entries were:

- Riley Allen, Lauren McClure and Allison Schueller were awarded a prize for their work involving the American legal system from the NC State Bar Assoc. for their documentary "*Hammer v. Dagenhart, the Fight for Child Labor in the South*"
- Maria Bassett, Allie Goulding and Grace Mullahy were awarded third place for their museum exhibit "*The Watergate Scandal: Presidency or Rule of Law?*"
- Joey Biersack, MJ DiFiore, Joey Milazzo and Colin Whelehan were awarded second place for their documentary "*The Berlin Airlift: Saving West Berlin from Communism One Plane at a Time.*"

On June 10th, seventh graders Joey Biersack, MJ DiFiore, Joey Milazzo and Colin Whelehan will join nearly with nearly 3,000 other middle and high school students from around the world at the 2018 NHD National Contest at the University of Maryland in College Park. This competition consists of is between the top entries of the more than 600,000 students that competed in the National History Day Contest from regional and state competitions. Contestants represent all 50 states, the District of Columbia, American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico and international schools in Central America, China, Korea, and South Asia.
