APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. All applicants MUST complete a Catholic school enrollment application.
- 2. Complete the N.C. Opportunity Scholarship program application (https://www.ncseaa.edu/k12/opportunity) between February 1st and March 1st before this application will be considered.
- 3. Then apply to the Tuition Assistance Program at the link provided below. Application opens on January 31, 2021 and closes on March 12, 2021. https://raldioc.configio.com/pd/544/2020-aamen-native-american-tuition-assistance.
- 4. Decision letters will be mailed to parents no later than May 21, 2021.
- 5. Tuition awards are sent from the diocese to the applicant's school.





CATHOLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS of AFRICAN ANCESTRY and NATIVE AMERICAN HERITAGE (K-12th grade) in the Diocese of Raleigh are eligible to apply for tuition assistance.

The assistance awards are funded by parish second collection donations and a grant from the Black and Indian Mission Office founded by the Catholic bishops of the United States.
